South Suburban's Little's Creek Park Pond Dredging Project Nearing Completion

Although it's unsightly, dredging is a necessary and vital maintenance practice in keeping South Suburban's ponds clean and healthy. Little's Creek Park Pond in Littleton is being dredged due to high amounts of sedimentation that have collected over many years, including recent inundation of sediment collected during the Sept. 2013 rains.

South Suburban Park and Recreation District (SSPRD) manages the park, while the City of Littleton owns the park. SSPRD and the City are equally funding the project with a \$40,000 match. SSPRD is also coordinating efforts with Southeast Metro Stormwater Authority (SEMSWA) and the City of Littleton in restoring the integrity of the entire culvert which connects Little's Creek on the east side of Broadway to the Little's Creek Park Pond on the west side of Broadway. RMC Consultants is the general contractor, and work is expected to be completed in late March. The area will be totally restored with new sod and section of a new pathway in the coming months.
