South Suburban Continues Efforts to Conserve

South Suburban Park and Recreation District will discontinue towel service at its four recreation centers and Littleton Golf and Tennis Club effective Mon., Aug. 19 in an effort to strengthen the District's commitment to caring for the environment.

The new move coincides with the District's water conservation program and will save more than 850,000 gallons of water annually, in addition to reducing consumption of electricity and gas. The District wants to spread the word now so that patrons will get in the habit of bringing a towel with them when they work out. Towel service will be eliminated at Buck, Goodson, Lone Tree and Sheridan recreation centers, and the Littleton Golf and Tennis Club.

Towels that have been in circulation will be given out, one towel per customer, until they are gone. The District also will recycle some of its inventory of previously used towels for cleaning and other purposes at South Suburban facilities.

Brand new towels will be available for sale through the District's pro shops at Goodson, Sheridan, Buck and Lone Tree recreation centers and at Littleton Golf and Tennis Club.
