**South Suburban's Public Art Committee Lands Sculpture at Hudson Gardens**

Thanks to the efforts of members of South Suburban Park and Recreation District's Public Art Committee, Hudson Gardens and Event Center has gained an additional attraction to its already diverse artistic landscape. A sculpture by local artist Joshua Wiener was installed at the 30-acre display gardens in Littleton earlier this month.

The piece, entitled, "Collective- Nest" is located just west of the amphitheatre. The sculpture soars 22' high and is 24' wide. The sculpture is made of stainless steel and mild steel. Aside from the stainless steel animals, the entire piece is designed to rust. Allowing the sculpture to oxidize will create a protected surface that doesn't need any regular maintenance.

According to members of South Suburban's Public Art Committee, "it was the right art for the right spot," noting that approximately 120,000 annual visitors to Hudson Gardens will enjoy this one-of-a-kind piece.

The sculpture was shipped to Hudson Gardens in two pieces, and the pieces were bolted together on site. The sculpture will be on display indefinitely, and is not for sale.
