South Suburban Hosts 34th Annual High Line Canal Run in deKoevend Park

The third event in South Suburban's Race Series is the 34th annual High Line Canal Run on Sat., May 9 in deKoevend Park. The event features a 10K at 8 am and a 5K Run/Walk at 9 am.

Walk or run along the scenic and relatively flat High Line Canal Trail. Children and friendly dogs welcome. Registration includes a pancake breakfast, Breckenridge Brewery beer for participants age 21 and older, a long sleeve race shirt, goody bag and prize drawings. Awards will be given to top male and female finishers in both the 10K and 5K race. Colorado Race Timing will be chip timing the event.

Race fee is \$35 and \$25 for ages 14 and under. Register online at www.RunningGuru.com/Event/HighLine.
