South Suburban Park and Recreation District Reminds Residents that Ballots must be Returned by Nov. 4

South Suburban Park and Recreation District wants to remind residents that South Suburban's ballot question 4C is on the same mail ballot for the congressional and gubernatorial election.

If members of the community have not received a ballot, they should call their home county's Clerk & Recorder.

Ballots need to be mailed, along with the proper 70 cents postage, by Tues., Nov. 4 to your county. Arapahoe County voters may drop off their signed ballots at South Suburban's Goodson Recreation Center, Mon. – Fri., from 9 am – 5 pm; Sat., Oct. 25 and Nov. 1 from 9 am – 3 pm; and on Election Day, Tues., Nov. 4 from 7 am – 7 pm. Goodson Recreation Center is located at 6315 S. University Blvd., Centennial.

The Ballot Question provides that South Suburban would use the funding for general operations and other purposes including:

- * Protect and enhance the High Line Canal Trail, the South Platte River Trail (Mary Carter Greenway) and other local trails;
- * Repair, maintain and improve existing parks, recreation facilities and playgrounds;
- * Replace outdated mechanical equipment with new energy saving systems including solar energy; and
- * Save water by replacing aging and inefficient irrigation systems in parks and using non-treated water where feasible.
