South Suburban Seeks Partners for Arts Outreach Program

South Suburban Park and Recreation District is seeking partners for its Arts Outreach Program. The District is accepting applications from organizations and schools interested in partnering with South Suburban's professional art staff in providing specialty art, dance or performing arts workshops for schools, libraries, senior centers, or other community groups in 2014. Organizations need to be located within both the park district and Arapahoe County boundaries to be considered for the program.

Projects could include classes, performances, or the creation of permanent artwork installed in a school. South Suburban's Culture and Enrichment Division is seeking funding from the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District (SCFD) through the Arapahoe County Cultural Council to provide these outreach programs in 2014.
